Position Title: Behavioral Health Clinical Supervisor (Part-time)

APA Family Support Services (APA) is a community-based organization that focuses on the prevention and identification of child abuse/neglect in the Asian and Pacific Islander (API) community. Our mission is to promote healthy children and families by providing family support services to prevent child abuse and domestic violence and to advocate for culturally competent services through education, community building, and leadership development. APA is San Francisco's foremost advocate and service provider for immigrant, monolingual, and at-risk API children and their families. Our services range from prevention to crisis intervention to community development. We strive for excellence of service in areas which include home visitation, case management, parenting education, support groups, parental stress line, child welfare redesign projects and counseling for San Francisco families with children ages 0-18.

We currently have an opening for a Behavioral Health Clinical Supervisor. We provide culturally sensitive counseling and group support in multiple languages. Our program offers both school based and center based therapeutic services to San Francisco residents. Our goal is to promote and maintain a safe and happy home environment for our families. We aim to help children, youth, individuals and families by nurturing growth, empowerment, and resilience through individual and family therapy. We specifically offer therapeutic support to strengthen caring relationships and increase emotional/behavioral well-being. We use evidence-based therapeutic interventions as it fits within the individual's and family's cultural context.

Major Duties and Responsibilities:

1. Provide weekly direct individual (or dyadic) supervision for master's level psychotherapy trainees, including guidance for crisis intervention, risk assessment and mandated reporting as needed.
2. Provide weekly clinical group supervision
3. Evaluate trainee's progress

4. (Knowledge of)
 - Legal and ethical guidelines for providing therapeutic services and clinical supervision,
 - Documentation practices that meet MediCal requirements,
 - Cultural humility, curiosity, and honor in therapeutic practices,
 - Basic to advanced/nuanced therapeutic techniques, and
 - Psychodynamic, attachment based, trauma and culturally informed approaches to psychotherapy
5. Interview and select trainees
6. Conduct orientation at the beginning of each academic year
7. Ensure clinical documentation is accurate and follows regulatory guidelines
8. Collaborate with partnered schools to ensure implementation of therapeutic services
9. Connect with in-house staff from other APA's program and professionals at other community-based organizations for implementation of therapeutic services and referrals
10. Work closely with Behavioral Health Administrator & Director of Programs to ensure the smooth operation of the program
11. Represent the agency in community meetings, and act as a liaison with outside agencies
12. Provide consultations and education on mental health to staff
13. Perform other duties as may be assigned

Minimum Qualification:

- CA licensed LMFT, LCSW or Clinical Psychologist with two years post-licensure experience
- Proven ability to train clinicians in assessments, diagnosis, and treatment planning
- Proven ability to work with people from diverse ethnic, socioeconomic, educational, religious, sexual/gender orientations and generational backgrounds
- Experience with EMR (electronic medical record) preferred
- Familiarity and experience working with community-based organizations and city government agencies
- Skills: Excellent supervisory skills; excellent organizational and task management skills; conflict resolution skills
- Valid California Driver's License and proof of vehicle insurance
- Must pass Background check and TB test clearance
